The Illinois Economics Association (IEA) is soliciting papers and organized sessions for the 47<sup>th</sup> annual meeting of the IEA to be held Friday and Saturday, October 13-14, 2017 at DePaul University's Downtown Campus. The aim of the conference is to bring together scholars, researchers, and students from **all areas of economics**. Tentative session topics include microeconomics, macroeconomics, health economics, public economics, labor economics, law and economics, international economics, financial economics, economic history, history of economic thought, economic development, urban economics, economic education, monetary economics, and various others.

Individuals are invited to submit proposals for organized sessions and individual paper abstracts to Professor Jin Man Lee (IEA President-elect) at [jlee141@depaul.edu](mailto:jlee141@depaul.edu). **Proposals are due Friday, September 1, 2017** and should include a general JEL classification. Proposals for complete sessions (3 to 4 papers with discussants) are encouraged. If you plan to attend the conference, yet are not presenting a paper, please let us know if you are willing to serve as a discussant or session chair by contacting Professor Grote as well.

Ph.D.-Student Paper Competition: The IEA will once again be organizing a competition for Ph.D. students. Three or four papers will be chosen to be presented on Saturday, October 14, 2017 for a monetary prize competition. Papers that students are co-authoring with faculty are not eligible for the paper competition, but are welcome to be presented at the regular conference sessions, as are all Ph.D. or Masters-level student papers. Any graduate students interested in presenting at the conference, including those in the paper competition who we hope will also present during the conference, should also submit their papers to Jin Man Lee at [jlee141@depaul.edu](mailto:jlee141@depaul.edu) by the same deadline.
