MISCELLANEOUS REQUIREMENTS

550 Teaching Seminar - may not be taken before the third year (unless Master's degree completed prior to second year). Three-quarter course, with the first quarter beginning in Winter of the student's third year (not Fall).

595 Colloquium (0 hours) – You must register for 595 every quarter, including summers, until you complete the program.

597 Thesis Research (4 hours) – You should register for thesis hours during one quarter in your second year.

598 Dissertation Seminar (0 hours) – After you pass comps, you must register for 598 each quarter until you complete the program.

599 Dissertation Research (12 hours) – After you pass comps, you can register for 1 to 12 dissertation hours in any given quarter; you must register for a total of 12 dissertation hours.

701 Candidacy Continuation (0 hours) – After you pass comps, you must register for 701 in any quarter in which you are not registered for dissertation hours.

History & Systems – This course is now an elective, and there is no longer an H&S requirement for the Experimental Psy PhD
