Through this partnership, the Management Development Center and ProLima are able to provide students with a unique look at project management, combining both the academic and practitioner perspectives.

Goals

Introduction to the basic Project Management Institute (PMI) theories and practices of Project Management in industry.

PMP Certificate Program is a two-day course for preparing project managers to take the PMP exam. This course is not intended to be a basic PM skills course and will not review any specific tools or technology but rather will focus on the framework within the PMBOK as well as techniques for passing the PMP certification exam. The course will include time for practice exams and for discussion sessions concerning various aspects of the PMBOK.
