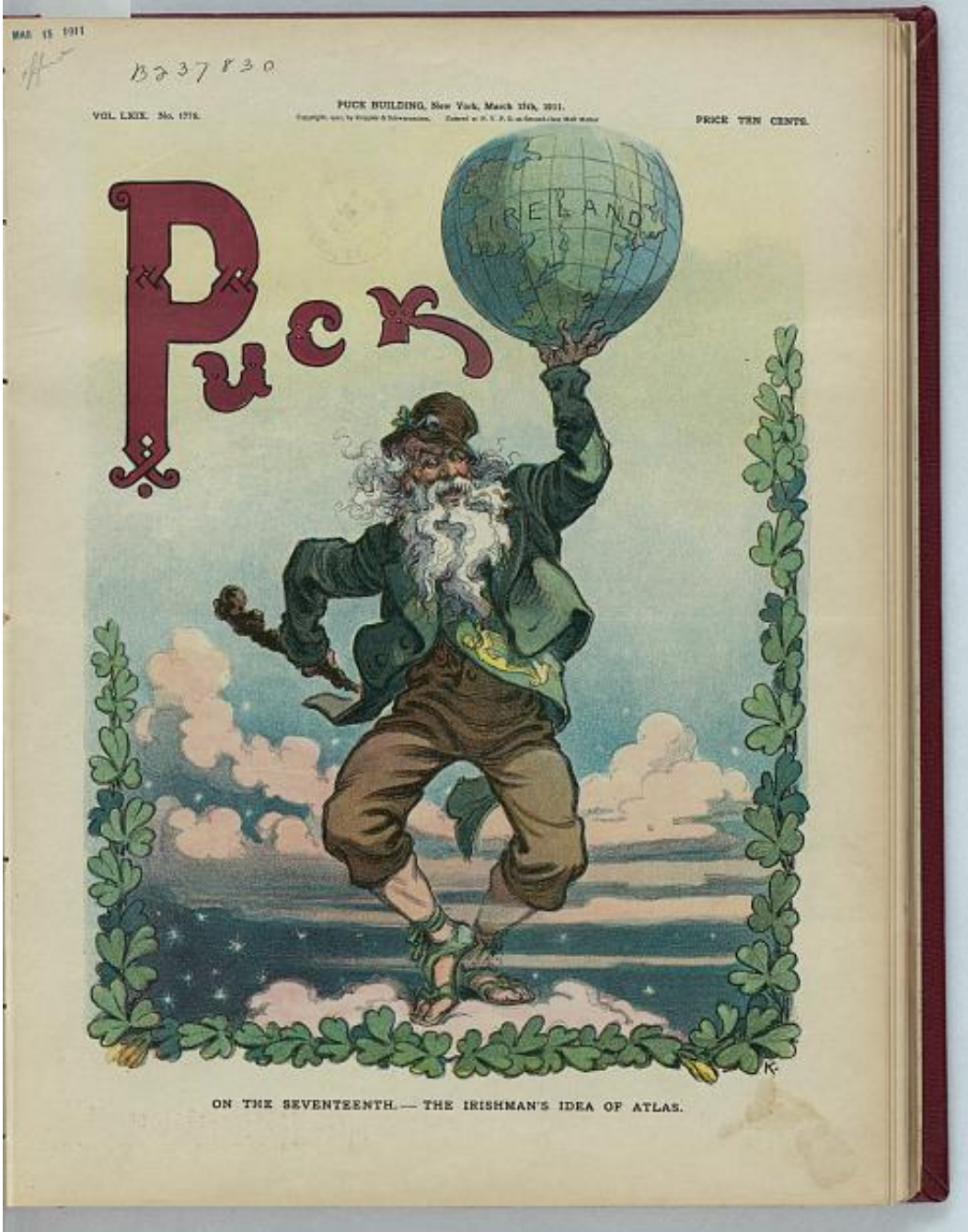
Summer Teacher Institutes
