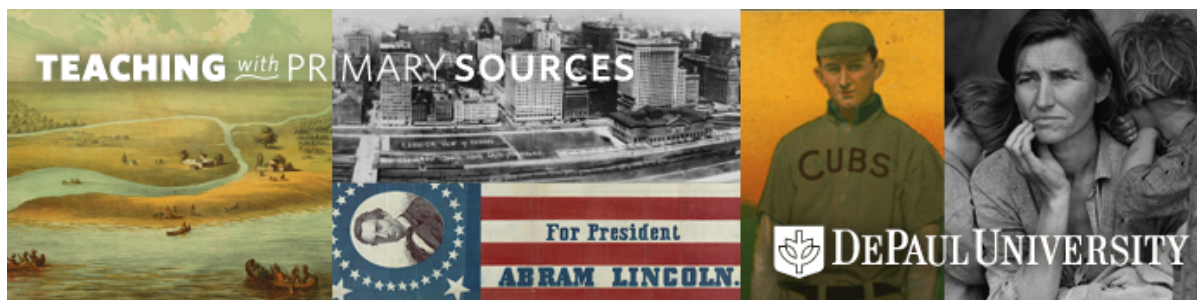

Veterans History Project

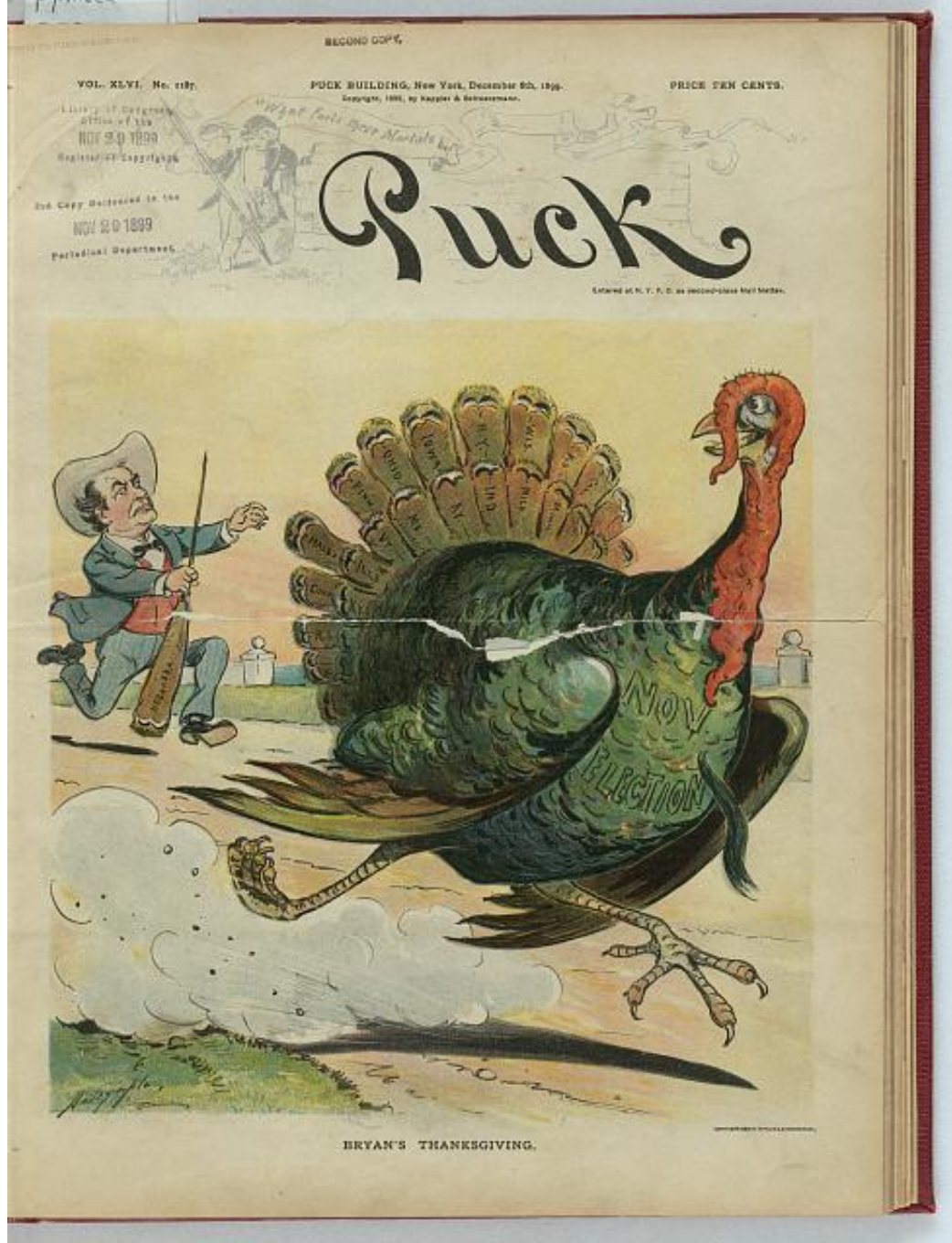
