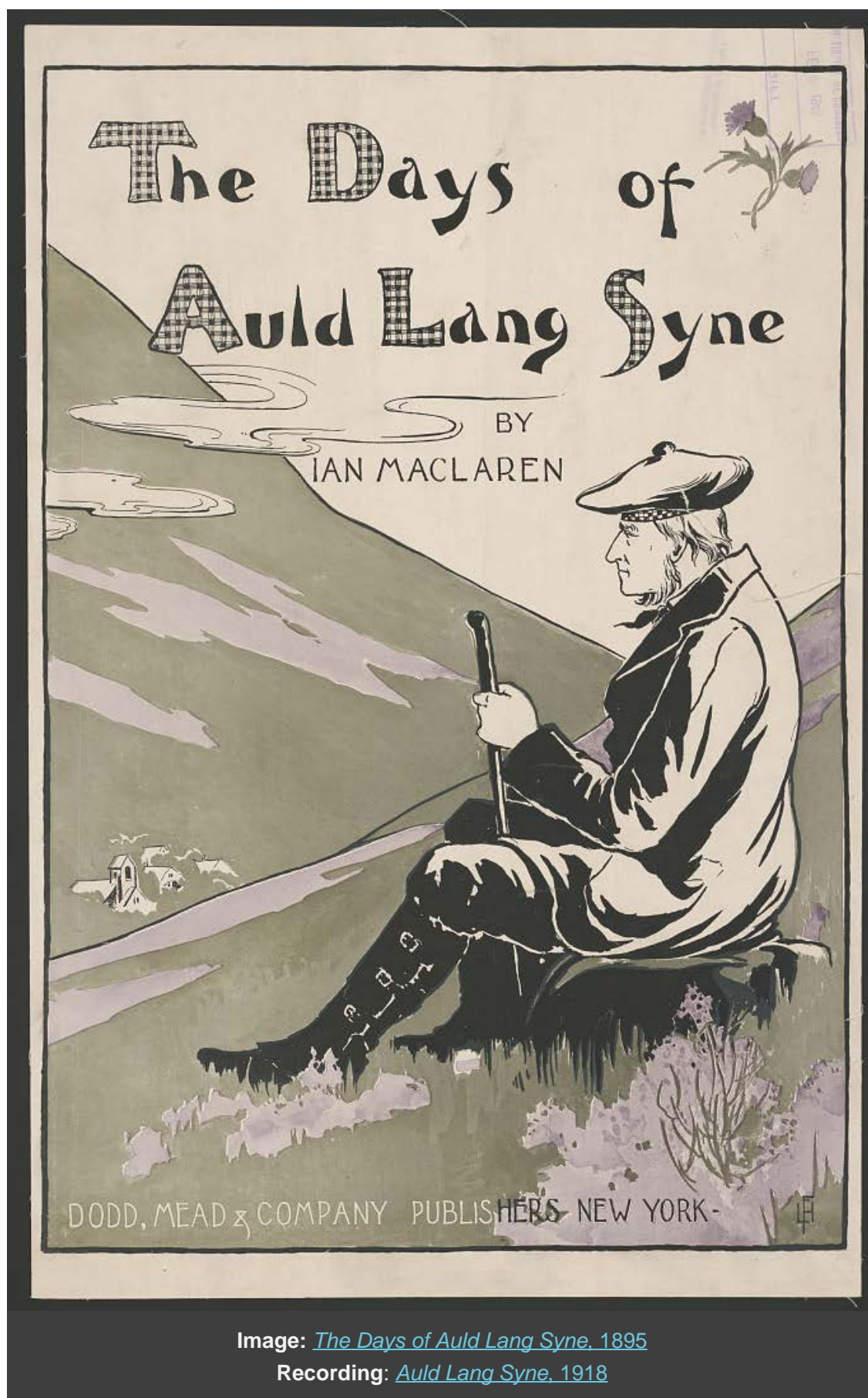


Image: [The Days of Auld Lang Syne, 1895](#)
