Copyright & Why You Should Care

Protection of original works of authorship...the recorded expression of the creator's idea.


- How do you tell if something is copyrighted?
- Even though you cite a source, its use may not be allowed. Not all primary sources are going to be in public domain!
- All part of getting students to critically examine (the source of) a record

Copyright and the Source

 Getting students to think about where and how they are using sources

 Just because it's on the internet, doesn't mean it's free to use

• Is it transformative use or just plagiarism?



Using Digital Resources

- Check copyright restrictions, even with LOC resources
- Use proper citation. It's ethical, scholarly, and promotes critical thinking



- URL (Uniform Resource Locator):
 - 'Temporary' versus 'static'
 - 'Access' versus 'source'
 - Shortened & base/home
- Using URLs alone as citation (hint: nope)
- Outdated citation guides
 - MLA 7 doesn't require URLs
- Blogs and social media "citation" (attribution)



What is credibility?

Slave auctions were brutal sights. The open selling of human flesh under the hammer, sometimes with cattle and horses, was among the most revolting aspects of slavery. On the auction block, families were separated with distressing frequency, usually for economic reasons such as bankruptcy or the division of "property" among heirs. The sundering of families in this fashion was perhaps slavery's greatest psychological horror. Abolitionists decried the practice, and Harriet Beecher Stowe seized on the emotional power of this theme by putting it at the heart of the plot of *Uncle Tom's Cabin*.
