

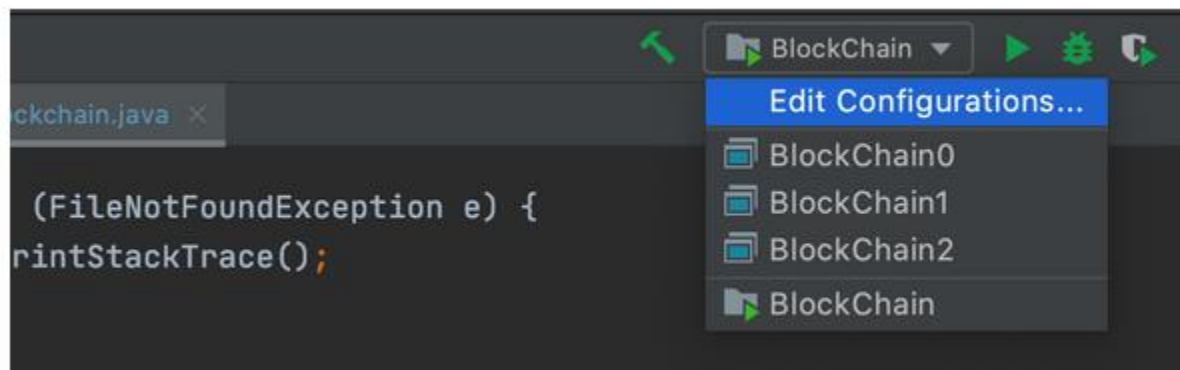
# Running 3 processes together in IntelliJ

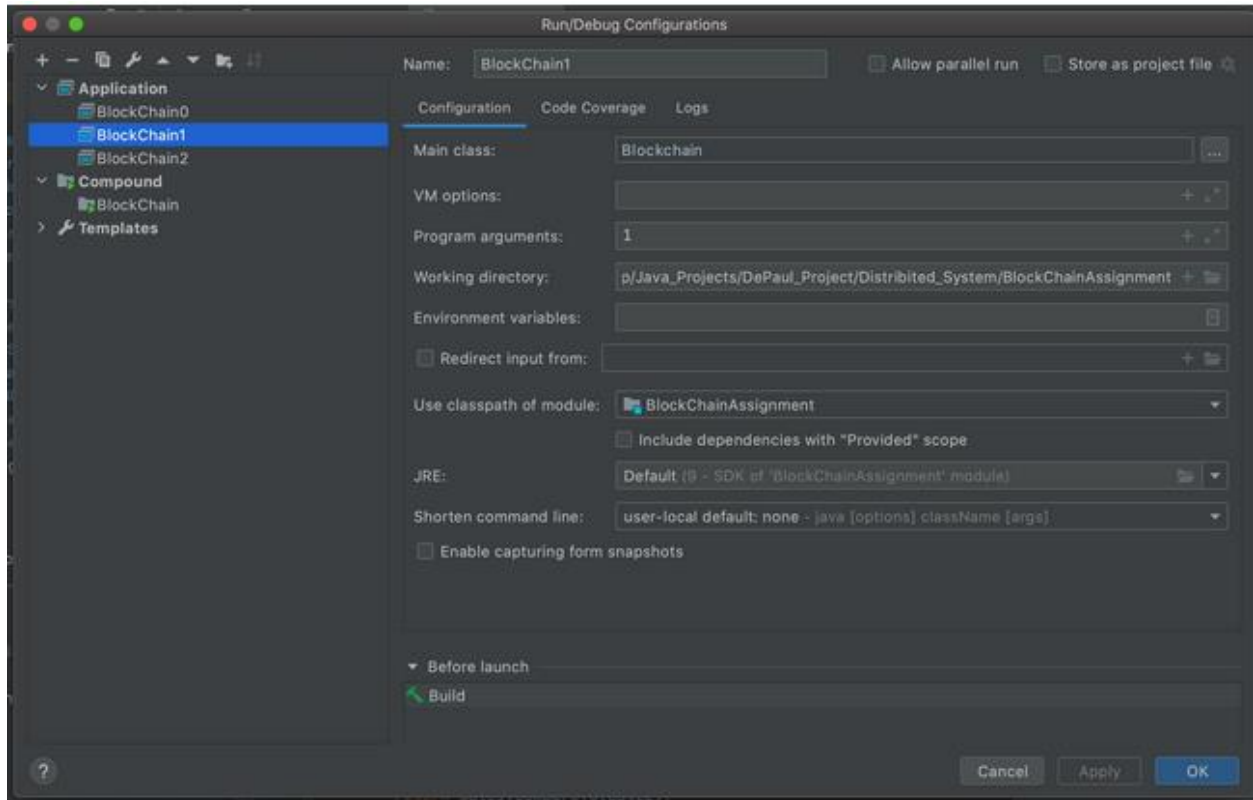
Hey All,

Earlier, I was facing difficulty in creating and executing an AppleScript to start the 3 processes together (process coordination). I tried the help provided by the professor here - <https://condor.depaul.edu/~elliott/435/hw/programs/Blockchain/UnixScriptA.html> But, still unable to execute the scripts. I am using IntelliJ for developing my blockchain code. So, as a workaround and executing the code manually this is what I did in IntelliJ IDE:

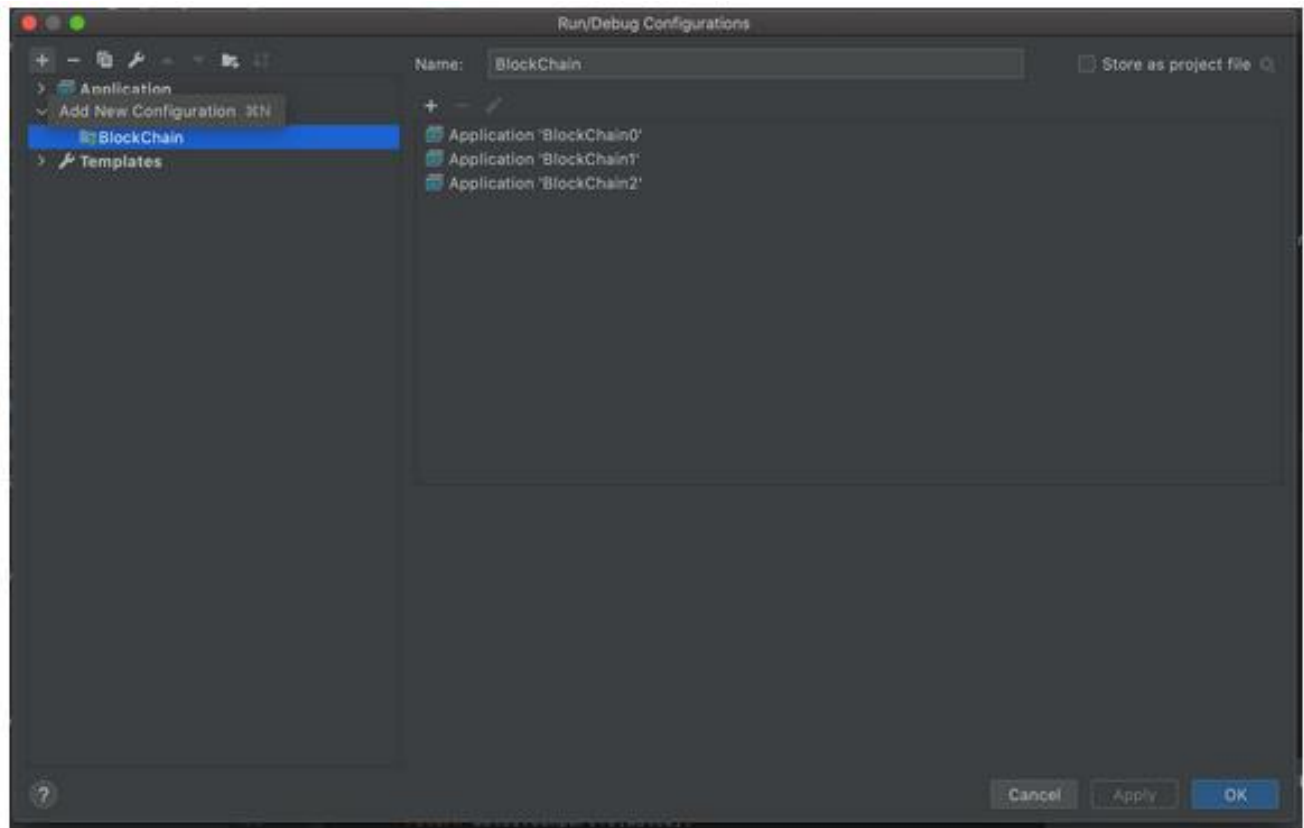
1) Go to Edit Configurations



2) Create 3 Applications - 1 for each process entering the parameters (arguments - 0,1,2) in it.



3) Once done, click on the '+' button, Click on the Compound option -> Add all the 3 applications -> Done. This will help you create one single executable for all the 3 processes. And, clicking on it will help you run all the 3 processes simultaneously.
